AGGRAVATED ASSAULT

On 07/5/11, Michelle Jones, of the first block of S. 8th Street, Perkasio was arrested for Aggravated Assault, Resisting Arrest, and lesser charges after interfering with an assault investigation at 42 S. 8th Street, Perkasio Borough. Jones was remanded to Bucks County Prison.

On 07/06/11, Jason Plenderleith, 30, of Hickory Lane, Coopersburg, was also arrested for Aggravated Assault and lesser charges, after his release from the hospital. Plenderleith had attacked another resident of 42 S. 8th Street with a knife on 07/05 and was injured while being disarmed by the assault victim. Plenderleith was remanded to Bucks County Prison as well.

FORCED ENTRY

TOBACCO SALES TO MINORS

Other tobacco retailers in Perkasio and Sellersville were checked and refused to sell to the undercover minor.
